William Sandes, baptised at St. Beas, 1897, was one of the "Forty-nine Officers," being named in the Inrolments of the Adjudications in favour of (A.D. 1649) Officers (formerly denominated "the 491 etc."), being one of the Army of Commissioned Officers on the waiting list for a Grant of Lands from the Crown in recognition of having served in the Wars of Ireland previous to 24th June, 1649, in the reign of Charles I. He also applied for lands by virtue of service in Ireland during the Commonwealth period; and, having received large grants of land in Co. Kerry, consisting of a great portion of the confiscated estates of the House of O'Connor, whose seat was Carrigrohilly Castle, he settled there, and was ancestor of the Sandes of Carrigrohilly. Lancelot Sandes, of Carrigrohilly, Co. Kerry, also claimed lands by virtue of serving in Ireland during the Commonwealth period, and received certain grants. Was M.P. 1681, High Sheriff 1690, d. 1698, will dated 24th March, 1688, proved 16th Feb., 1699 (Prærogative Wills of Ireland). See Appendix Note 118.
